

Dietetic interns who withdraw from the program voluntarily are eligible for a refund of the fees according to the guidelines below. Interns who withdraw voluntarily from the program must submit their intention to withdraw in written form to the Internship Director.

Fees are paid by the dietetic interns for the following purposes according to the following schedule:

A \$50.00 or \$75.00 application fee is paid by each applicant to the program and accompanies the required application materials. The application fee is paid each time the applicant applies to the program.

A \$1000.00 deposit for tuition is due within two months (on an assigned date given to the intern by the director in the acceptance letter) from when the applicant accepts the appointment to the dietetic internship program.

The remaining tuition is due in full on the first day of the program.

The schedule for payments is not subject to changes unless approved by the director in extenuating circumstances.

Refunds in fees paid will be made according to the following guidelines:

No refund will be made for the application fee (\$50.00 or \$75.00) for applicants who are considered for admission to the dietetic internship program. Applicants who are considered are those who submit a complete application packet postmarked no later than the date of the application deadline.

Application packets that are not received by the application deadline will not be evaluated for admission into the program and will be returned to the applicant along with the application fee.

No refund will be made on the initial tuition deposit paid (\$1000.00) when the intern accepts the appointment to the program. This includes voluntary resignation and termination resulting from disciplinary procedure.

The remaining tuition will not be refunded once the intern starts the internship since the intern will not be able to be replaced with another intern.
