



## Preselect Option

Please note that the preselect option is only open to applicants who are applying to the internship ([DI](#) or [MSDI options](#))

### Applicants interested in early acceptance to the URI Graduate Program (GP)

can submit their GP application to DICAS prior to January 13<sup>th</sup>, which is the Early Acceptance Deadline for the URI Graduate Program. Please visit [URI's website](#) for more information.

Our program has 40 preselect slots per year reserved for applicants who are either:

- Enrolled in a University of Georgia graduate program
- Employed by Sodexo in any segment as a manager or a frontline employee, or
- Employed by a Sodexo client **and** are supervised by a Sodexo manager

There are no additional costs for participating in the preselect application process.

Follow the steps below if you would like to participate in the pre-selection process:

- Submit your application to DICAS along the application fee by
  - August 18<sup>th</sup> for the Fall Match, and
  - January 18<sup>th</sup> for the Spring Match.

Note: when completing the DICAS application, select that you are applying to programs that do not use D&D Digital. If you are not accepted as a preselect candidate, you have the ability to register with D&D and enter the number in prior to February 15<sup>th</sup> (Spring) or September 25<sup>th</sup> (Fall).

If you are planning to apply for the Spring Match, request your transcript early to avoid a delay in obtaining your transcript because of holiday related closures.

  - Dates of employment with Sodexo or client

You will be informed of your acceptance status no later than February 1<sup>st</sup> (Spring Match) or September 1<sup>st</sup> (Fall Match). If successful, you do not have to participate in the D&D Digital computer matching. Preselect applicants who are not accepted have time to apply to other programs.
